Map 2016 – Challenge

- Publish a web map or web map application
 - You are free to choose the topic or you may select the topic from the themes given by the challenge partners
 - The map or the application may make use of own data, open data and/or own organisation's proprietary data
 - The published map or map application has to be freely available until the end of 2016
- Implementation is free; GIS software, other digital tool, manual drawing etc.

1. General

- Open for anybody interested in maps and cartography, including professionals

2. Students

- Open for any students utilising maps and cartography in their studies

Map 2016 – Participate

- Submit your work until **17.10.2016** to the address **sihteeri@kartogra.fi**
- Submission has to contain...
 - Series (general/students) and topic (free/theme by the partner)
 - Link to your web map or web map application
 - Author: name, (organisation), email/phone number
 - Title of the map, short description about the purpose of the map, implementation methods and data description

Map 2016 – Evaluation

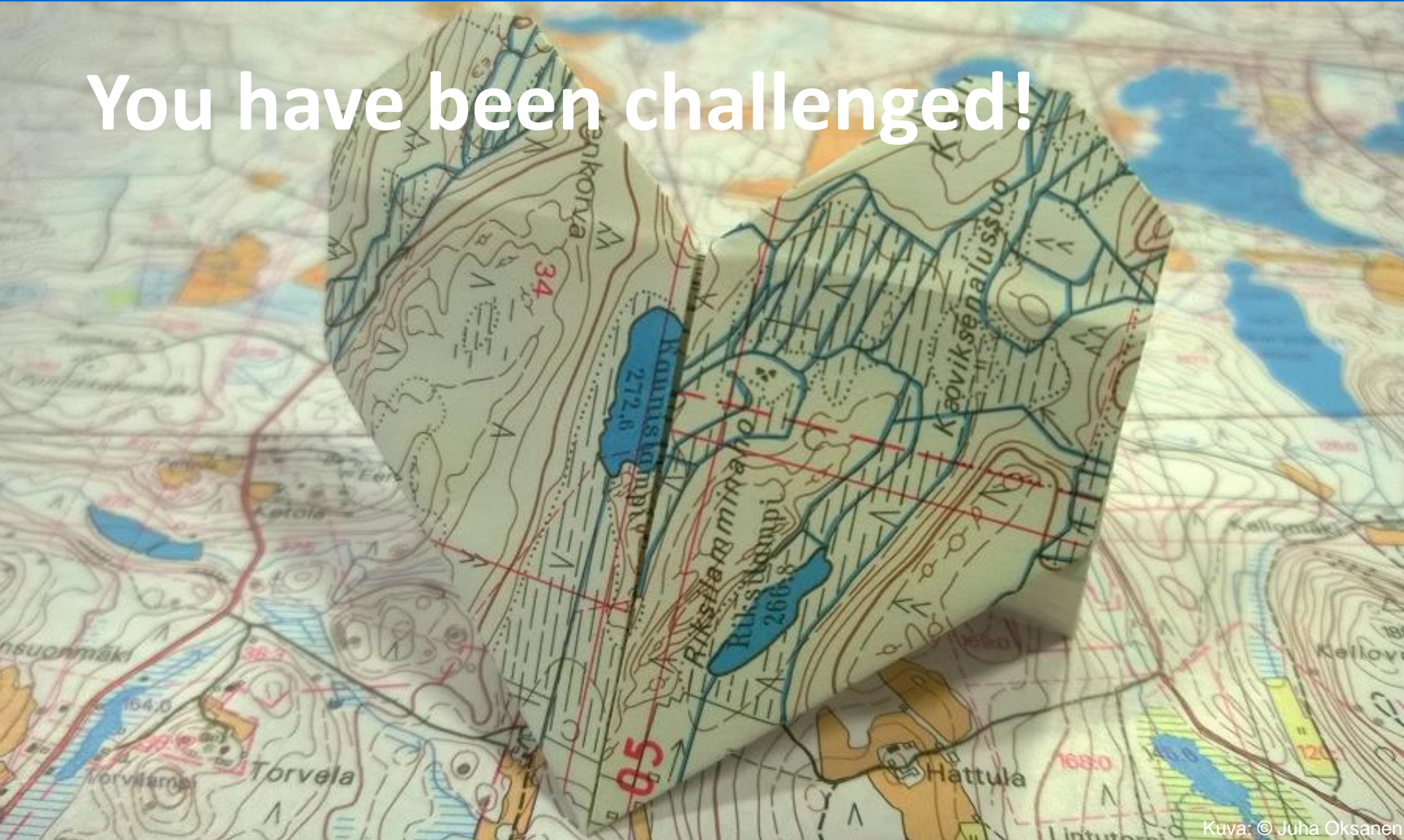
- Purpose of the map is clear

- The awarded works will represent Finland in the International Map Exhibition during the ICC 2017, Washington DC, 2.–7.7.2017
- The best works will be published in the web pages of SKS
